



6th Sense Technologies – Dashcam benefits:

What does a Dashcam do?

A Dashcam will record what you see when sitting behind the wheel of your vehicle. It will store the video recorded in its internal memory for you to use when you need it.

Why do I need a Dashcam?

There has been much press lately about Dashcams and it seems that they are becoming not only fashionable but provide financial benefits along with peace of mind, and they are not going to go away. That is until Manufacturers fit cameras into vehicles as standard – from 2018 all vehicles sales in the US require a reversing camera to be installed and onboard cameras are being made available for full 360-degree coverage by a number of manufacturers.

How long will it record for?

The unit is programmed to loop its recording and record over the earlier video ongoing. So effectively for as long as you have the unit in operation. The recordings are made onto memory cards so the larger capacity card(s) you have the more data it can hold. The cards can be easily removed and replaced and the files can be downloaded onto your computer for playback.

Will it keep the important videos I need such as the record of an accident?

The important events are stored separately on the memory card in an area that will NOT be automatically overwritten. Event files can be created manually by pressing the button to start a record or alternatively by its built-in G-Sensor recording a significant shock such as a collision. These excerpts can be downloaded to be kept and then the memory card returned to the Dashcam.

What do I do if I need to use the video evidence?

Speak to your Insurer, your Solicitor or the Police about what they need. You can easily show them the video by simply removing the unit from the car and playing the film back on the unit. If you haven't already, you can then download the file(s).

Can I report bad driving by using recorded footage?

Yes, the UK Police have set up a website the "National Dash Cam Safety Portal" where you can upload files. Our Kestrel device is fully compatible.

Will it work 24/7?

Normally the unit will work when the ignition is on only. However, the unit contains a G-Sensor that monitors for any impact or shock. If the vehicle receives a significant shock such as being driven into when parked, the unit will turn on and start recording.

The standard unit does not record all the time. If you have concerns about where you leave your vehicle then please talk to us as there are a number of ways, we can provide peace of mind.

What does it cost to install?

The standard DIY installation is to fix the unit to the inside of the windscreen behind the rear-view mirror using the suction mounting bracket supplied at no cost. The power lead can then be routed to a 12V socket (Cigarette lighter). It is possible to hide the wiring behind the roof lining and dash and additional cables are available to support this. A professional install is also possible if required and we can provide contact details for approved contractors.

Can I extend the system?

Certainly; additional cameras, storage methods, larger monitor screen and much more is possible. We supply a full 360-degree internal and external systems with data transfer, etc.. to the "Blue Light" market. Please enquire about any additional requirements you have, and we will be happy to provide advice and quotes.

Can I get discounted insurance premiums?

You should always check with your Insurer to make sure you aren't missing out.

There is a number, increasing all the time, of enlightened Insurers who will consider discounts (10 to 30%) when a Dashcam is fitted. Some provide a minimum specification of a system (Ours will almost certainly comply) and others require specific approval for listing of suitable units. If we are not already on any list you need us to be, we will gladly respond and provide all the necessary details to get onto any list we may have missed. How much can the Dashcam see?

The standard unit has a 170-degree field of horizontal vision. The High Definition quality of the data captured means that zooming in to look at distant objects, identifying people, reading car number plates are all possible. Take still photos:


